

## Where to use on board - Crew Guide

Always follow manufacturers instructions for use and NEVER use on hot surfaces- if in doubt ASK your team leader or email us on [info@deeplycleanmarine.com](mailto:info@deeplycleanmarine.com) to see if we can help.

- Use wet on large areas during the wash down process.
- With a light soaking on teak decking will remove stains.
- Wet on non-slip surfaces.
- Organic material and oil build up on the waterline is easily removed.

Generally on all other surfaces lightly wet the target surface and clean in the direction of the grain if it has one. Do not use aggressive small circular cleaning movements on any surface whilst cleaning unless the product is used for buffing and polishing at speeds less than 400 rpm.
